PRIME TIME: November through mid-April.

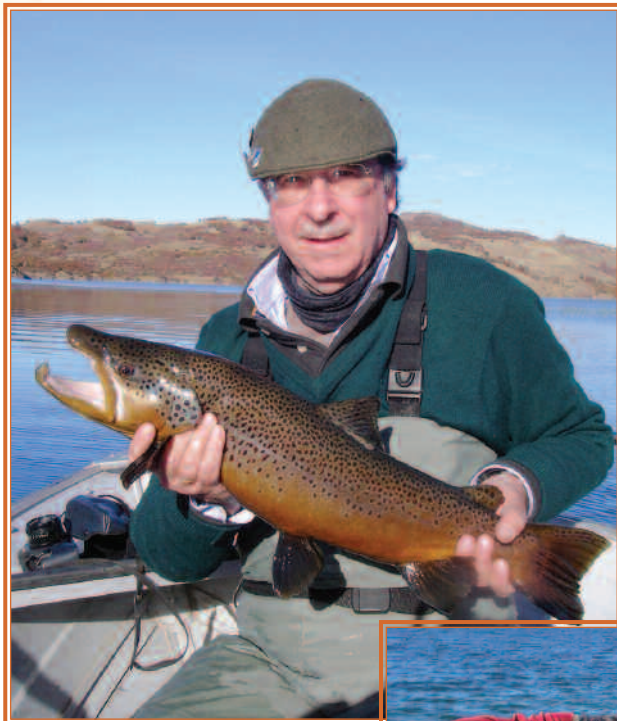
HOW TO GET THERE: American and Delta offer daily service to Santiago, Chile, as does Lan Chile, the Chilean national airline. All of the flights depart in the evening and arrive early in the morning at the Santiago International Airport. A onetime \$130 entry fee is collected at Customs. After receiving your luggage and clearing Customs, you'll be met and either transported to your hotel for overnight, or you will walk a few minutes over to the domestic terminal where you'll connect for a 2 1/2-hour flight to Balmaceda. In Balmaceda, you will be met and transported in a private vehicle one hour to the lodge.

Salmo Patagonia Lodge offers an ever-expanding and varied selection of fishing in November through mid-April where you are, for the most part, the only anglers. On these exclusive waters, you can cast to rising brown or rainbow trout or tease up king and silver salmon in total seclusion. It is not uncommon for anglers to catch and release over 20-30 brown and rainbow trout per day. Our clients land trophy trout from 5 to 20 plus pounds every week. Salmo Patagonia Lodge offers the greatest variety and quantity of public and private waters in Chile, if not the world. It's the most consistent trout fishing on earth for size, quality and quantity. Superb dry fly, wet fly, streamer and nymph fishing all produce good numbers of trout. You may also sight fish with hoppers or over amazing mayfly hatches. You can

Nunca Jamás (Neverland Lake)

Big rainbows, 18-30 inches. Wade the flats and sight fish big hoppers and streamers. Expect to catch 10 to 20 trout or more a day.

Toqui River This incredible clear-water river holds king salmon averaging 40 pounds and silver salmon ranging from 15 to 20 pounds in 8 miles of water. Wade fish for salmon and brown trout.

Nirehuao River Antunez controls access to 10 miles of this prolific river full of brown trout up to 30 inches.

Z River Incredible hatches allow you to catch numbers of 10- to 16-inch trout while wading and dry fly fishing this classic chalkstream. Anglers routinely catch 30-plus fish per day. Late evening hatches produce some bigger trophy fish.

Alpine (Ghost) Lake Full of alpine rainbows that routinely feed on the surface allowing sight casting with dry flies while walking and wading the shallows and flats. Fishermen average releasing 20 fish each day and as many as 50 on some occasions. Fish average 14-20 inches—great fun on a 3- or 4-weight rod.

Elf River Sight fishing in a beautiful, remote chalkstream full of huge browns that run to 20 or more pounds. Anglers routinely catch 6- to 10-pound trophy trout. This is the most unique brown trout water on earth.

Small, but significant details comprise a great fishing program. For this reason, satellite phones are provided in all of the trucks for guests' safety and to assure any problems are quickly resolved. 4x4 ATVs are available just for fun or to save time and your legs during longer treks.

The fishing vehicles are late model supercab trucks outfitted with air conditioning and four wheel drive to accommodate any road and weather conditions encountered.

A good selection of float tubes is available for use, along with professionally maintained inflatable drift boats, and aluminum lake boats as well as a complete selection of fly fishing materials, rental rods, emergency waders and much more.

Newly constructed outcabins make it possible to overnight at some of the more remote premeire fisheries.
